KEY STONE is a 100% solids epoxy binder resin specially formulated for excellent clarity and improved resistance to degradation from ultraviolet (UV) light exposure. **KEY STONE** is used as a binder for "river rock" or natural stone surfacing for interior and exterior applications on plazas, patios, courtyards, and pool decks.

APPLICATION

SURFACE PREPARATION

Surface Preparation is the most critical portion of any successful resinous flooring system application. All substrates must be properly prepared as outlined in **Key Resin Technical Bulletin #1**. Work must be performed by trained or experienced contractors or maintenance personnel. Contact the **Key Resin Technical Service Department** with questions.

INSTALLATION

Installation of **KEY STONE** varies with the application. Typically, **KEY STONE** is blended with graded natural aggregates and troweled to a desired thickness. For complete installation instructions, contact **Key Resin Technical Service**.

CLEAN UP

Clean skin with soap and water. Tools and equipment should be cleaned with xylene or lacquer thinner. Consult Safety Data Sheet (SDS) for safety and health precautions.
